### **Resource Hub**

Technical assistance and support from Duke Faculty and Staff. Up to \$2,000 per project to launch and/or scale equity-focused projects. Up to \$1,000 honorarium for educators leading each project.



#### **Education Hub**

Six professional development sessions that focus on collaborative leadership, teachers as policy actors, and action research. \$50 stipend per session for educators.
